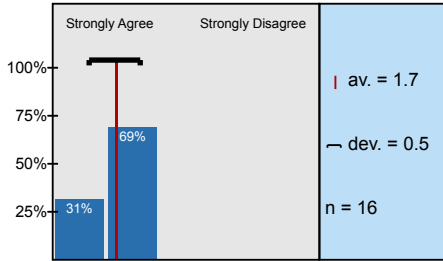

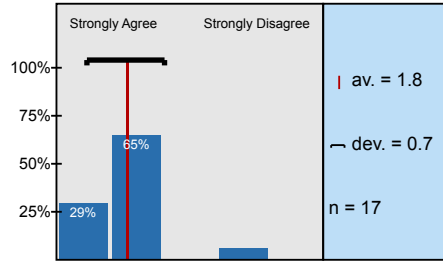


Histogram for scaled questions

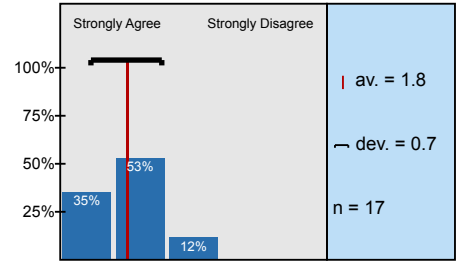
